**NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF THE FIFTH MEETING OF THE ADVISORY
COMMITTEE FOR AVIATION CONSUMER PROTECTION**

This notice announces the cancellation of the fifth meeting of the Advisory Committee for Aviation Consumer Protection originally scheduled for October 8, 2013, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Eastern Time, in the Quesada Auditorium at the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) headquarters at 800 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C. The Federal Register notice announcing this meeting was published Tuesday, September 10, 2013 (78 FR 55327).

Due to the lapse in funding of the Federal government on October 1, 2013, key preparations for the fifth committee meeting by law must be placed on hold until funding is resumed.
