NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

Description of the Incident:

Pet arrived Houston deceased upon arrival of the non-stop flight from Honolulu, Hawaii.

Description of the Cause of the Incident:

A necropsy was performed and stated that the pet was deceased from multifocal myocardial hemorrhage. There was insufficient evidence to determine the origins of the heart problem or why it occurred in the care of Continental Airlines but was likely a result of the normal stress of transport that proved too much for this very sensitive breed.

Description of any corrective action taken:

None as the cause of death was likely a preexisting condition and not related to Continental's handling.
