Dear Mr. Williams:

At your request, we remand the matter of DeLaRosa Technical Services & Fabrication, Inc. (DTS), for reconsideration. We do so without prejudice and with the understanding that CUCP may change its position and certify the DTS if it determines concludes that the firm is eligible. We express no opinion on the merits of the firm's application.

To further the purposes of your request and our disposition, we vacate CUCP's denial and dismiss DTS's appeal as moot. While CUCP may make reasonable requests for additional information, we ask that CUCP complete its review expeditiously. Please notify the firm of CUCP's decision, copying us, no later than close of business September 1, 2020.

If the decision is favorable, let us be the first to congratulate DTS. If not, any new appeal DTS files moves to the front of our queue.

This decision is administratively final.
