**Description of Incident:**

A 10 year old male Cock-A-Poo was accepted in Albany, NY (ALB) with a transfer and overnight kenneling in Detroit, MI (DTW) destined for San Francisco, CA (SFO) . The canine was accepted in apparent good health with all documentation present. The canine arrived in Detroit, MI and was transferred to kenneling services for overnight stay until the next day's flight to San Francisco, CA. Reagan was walked at 930PM by the kenneling service and appeared to be in good health. At approximately 6am on January 16th prior to transport back to DTW for the destination flight, kenneling services noticed 'Reagan' unresponsive. 'Reagan' was transported to Michigan State University for medical evaluation.

**Cause of Incident:**

According to the Necropsy report Reagan died from a Pheochromocytoma tumor inside the left adrenal gland as well as Mitral valve endocardiosis of the heart.

**Corrective Action Taken:**

'Reagan' died from pre-existing medical conditions. No corrective action taken.

**Description of Incident:**

(3) three pet cats were accepted for transport in Los Angeles, CA (LAX) on direct flight to Raleigh, NC (RDU). 'Blacky' 10 years old, 'Iggy' 10 years old, and 'George' 20 years old. The cats were accepted in apparent good health with all documentation present. All three were boarded on the flight from LAX with no irregularities reported. Upon arrival and offload in RDU (1) one of the three cats 'George', was noticed unresponsive. Local Delta staff in RDU made immediate contact with the owner.

**Cause of Incident:**

The pet owner elected to take George without medical evaluation to determine cause of death.

**Description of Incident:**

Two pet dogs, 'Oreo', a female Chihuahua mix, and 'Benny', a Jack Russell terrier mix were accepted for transport in Los Angeles, CA (LAX) for a direct flight to Memphis, TN (MEM). The dogs were accepted in apparent good health with all documentation present. Both were held in a climate controlled facility before the flight and subsequently transported to the aircraft in a climate controlled van. At time of loading, 'Oreo' was observed unresponsive and was dispatched to local medical care for evaluation. Local veterinary services in Los Angeles determined Oreo was deceased.

**Cause of Incident:**

According to the Necropsy report, Oreo suffered from a pre-existing medical condition known as hypertrophic cardiomyopathy.

**Corrective Action Taken:**

Pre-existing medical condition. No corrective action taken.
