Traveling by Air with Service Animals

AGENCY: Office of the Secretary (OST), U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT).

ACTION: Final rule; correction notice.

SUMMARY: The U.S. Department of Transportation (Department or DOT) published a final rule to amend the Department's Air Carrier Access Act (ACAA) regulation on the transport of service animals by air in the Federal Register on December 10, 2020 (85 FR 79742). This document corrects editorial errors or omissions in the preamble and rule text.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: In FR Doc. 2020-26679 appearing on page 79743 in the Federal Register of Thursday, December 10, 2020, the following corrections are made:
