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URGENT—Correction to AMJP application form (relating to size of the EEG)

DOT is updating and correcting an important detail in the AMJP application form and instructions, regarding the size of Eligible Employee Group (EEG).

On page 25, footnote #16 incorrectly stated that Row A "...must match the figure on page 1918, Line E." That footnote should have referred to page 18. The more substantive issue, however, is that the data on page 18 relates only to the applicant's workforce involved in aviation manufacturing or repair.

By contrast, the maximum size of the EEG is based on <u>total</u> U.S. workforce. Accordingly, we are correcting footnote #16 to read:

For many applicants, this figure may match the figure on page 18, Line E. However, in some cases it may not, because page 18 focuses solely on employees who are engaged in aviation manufacturing and repair. By contrast, this line (on page 25, Line A) relates to overall "United States workforce," regardless of whether it includes other business activities. Also see footnote #13 on page 18, defining "United States workforce."

We will correct the application form as quickly as possible. We are sending this message to notify all applicants immediately.
