## Transit Benefit Web Application System

**DATE:** October 3, 2022

**SUBJECT:** Multi-factor Authentication for the Transit Benefit Web Application System

**PURPOSE:** This communication is to inform your agency that the Transit Benefit Web Application System, used by federal employees to apply for transit benefits, will be implementing multi-factor authentication log-in requirements to enhance system security.

**INFORMATION:** Effective November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, logging into the Transit Benefit Web Application System will require Multi-factor Authentication (MFA) using the proven Login.gov solution- [The public's one account for government. | Login.gov](#). Login.gov is a digital identity provider that delivers strong authentication and identity verification which will increase the security of the Transit Benefit Web Application System.

**ACTION:** Beginning November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, federal transit benefit program participants will use Log.gov to access the Transit Benefit Web Application System - [Login - Transit Benefits System v 3.0 \(dot.gov\)](#). Program participants should follow the attached guide for instructions on Login.gov account set-up and use.
