Key takeaways from the webinar:

- The Implementation Report Guidance is available and is your best resource for preparing your Draft and Final Implementation Reports: [Grants Management | US Department of Transportation](#)
 - We have also published a list of resources that may support you in preparation of the reports, on the same webpage.
- All Draft Implementation Reports are **due 12 months from the date you signed your grant agreement**
- Final Implementation Reports are due **at the end of your period of performance** (18 months, or more, if you are granted an extension).
- The Stage 2 NOFO will be released this summer. **The Draft Implementation Report will be an important consideration in the Stage 2 NOFO application and evaluation.**
