Indicators of Human Trafficking

Human traffickers recruit, transport, and exploit their victims via roadways, railways, waterways, and airways in urban, rural, and tribal communities. Victims/traffickers can be of any age, race, ethnicity, sex, ability, nationality, citizenship, or socioeconomic background. ▶▶▶

Indicators of Human Trafficking

- Controlled movement, identification, money, documents, luggage, and speech
- Signs of physical/emotional distress, abuse, or branding
- Improper clothing for weather or travel route
- May travel with few/no belongings
- Logistically unaware of where they are, where they are going, or where they have been
- Answers may sound scripted/inconsistent
- May not know fellow traveler or who is picking them up
- May purchase in-person, one-way, last-minute or same-day tickets
- May use prepaid credit cards and gift cards
- References frequent travel to other cities or towns
