Date and time of the incident: June 27, 2024, 1:05 pm

Description of the animal: Catahoula mix named Amber.

Narrative description of the incident: Upon arrival the team members were concerned about the health condition of Amber and called a vet on site for an assessment. The HARC have confirmed Amber subsequently passed away. A euthanasia was carried out by the vet. No further details provided due to privacy laws in the UK, the air carrier may not receive any feedback from the veterinarian or request a necropsy, all must be obtained through the owner.

Date and time of the incident; July 30, 2024, 1:05 pm

Description of the animal: 11-year-old Greyhound named Toe Slam

Narrative description of the incident: Toe Slam and Stella were scheduled to travel to Charlotte, NC (CLT) on flight AA731/30Jul LHR-CLT (ETD 09:15 ETA 13:05). It was after arrival and staging in the American Airlines Cargo Terminal, Charlotte, NC (CLT) when it was noticed that Toe Slam seemed distressed, panting, and unable to maintain balance. Toe Slam was immediately transported to a Vet Specialist in Charlotte for evaluation. Toe Slam's owner arrived at the Carolina Vets location and elected humane euthanasia with cremation.

Narrative description of the cause of the incident: Examination concluded Toe Slam was suffering from heat stroke.
