Indicators of Human Trafficking

Human traffickers recruit, transport, and exploit their victims around pipeline worksites in urban, rural, and Tribal communities. Victims/traffickers can be of any age, race, ethnicity, sex, ability, nationality, citizenship, or socioeconomic background. ▶▶▶

Pipeline Indicators

- Traversing, trespassing, or solicitation in rights-of-way or construction areas.
- Signs of a struggle, discarded clothing, and/or living materials in rights-of-way or construction areas.
- Unauthorized personnel using construction sites for shelter.
- A vehicle that repeatedly drops off individuals and then returns a short while later to pick them up near man-camps, pipeline projects, mining or drilling areas, hotels/motels, and popular recreational areas.
- Inadequate workplace equipment/clothing for job.
- Works excessively long hours, is provided few/no breaks, and/or employer is withholding pay.
