 **Apply Online in the Electronic Application System.** Did you complete all line items?

Have you checked these items?

- ✓ Select CIVILIAN for employment type
- ✓ Make sure work schedule days minus telework days equals the # of days per month you're claiming – if telework is not taken, be sure to select 0 days
- ✓ If approving official is not known, please refer to the AO list
- ✓ Point of contact can be found by searching work location and selecting primary POC
- ✓ Making sure supervisor's phone number is provided
- ✓ All Regional participants are to place NA for smartrip card number
(smartrip cards only apply to Washington Metropolitan (DC, Maryland and Virginia) participants)

 **Register your TRANServe card on US Bank Access Online.** To have access to your available credit, balance, and bank profile information at all times.
