# ORDER

Subject: DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PARTICIPATION IN  
THE PROGRAM OF THE NATIONAL BOMB DATA CENTER

---

1. PURPOSE. This Order establishes the Office of Security, Office of the Secretary (OST), as the Department of Transportation (DOT) point of contact with the National Bomb Data Center (NBDC).
2. CANCELLATION. DOT 1660.3A, Department of Transportation Participation in the Program of the National Bomb Data Center, dated 8-5-76.
3. BACKGROUND. The OST Office of Security is the DOT liaison with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Department's point of contact with the NBDC. The NBDC is a central repository of technical information concerning explosive and incendiary devices and is operated by the FBI. The NBDC provides the following services:
  - a. Testing of selected items of bomb handling equipment; collection and analysis of data relating to bombing incidents, targets, techniques and materials; and distribution of this information in periodic summary reports.
  - b. Preparation and distribution of publications which provide technical information concerning explosives, firebombs and homemade devices; results of tests of selected items of bomb handling equipment; methods of improving security of potential targets; techniques for use at scenes of bombings and bomb disposal services.
  - c. Development of lessons and instructional material, and presentation of specialized classes concerning bomb related matters.
  - d. Maintenance of bibliographies concerning bombs and incendiary devices.
  - e. Assistance in the disposal of incendiary explosive devices is provided, if not available locally, by Army Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Detachments. A list with addresses and telephone numbers of these Army EOD Detachments is provided in Attachment 1.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES.

a. Office of Security. The OST Office of Security shall:

- (1) Provide Departmental liaison with the NBDC.
- (2) Receive all publications initiated by the NBDC and distribute these publications to those elements within the Department currently receiving this information.
- (3) Review and provide, as applicable, appropriate NBDC correspondence to those elements of the Department not currently receiving this information.
- (4) Process any future requests from the Operating Administrations for inclusion on the permanent Department distribution list.

b. Secretarial Offices and Operating Administrations. The Secretarial Offices and Operating Administrations shall:

- (1) Safeguard the content of all NBDC publications and deny access to all unauthorized personnel.
- (2) Notify the local FBI office by telephone of all actual bombings involving either explosive or incendiary devices. The OST Office of Security should also be notified when there has been a bombing.
