Getting Here

USDOT Headquarters, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE, Washington, DC 20590 (enter through the West building). The Navy Yard–Ballpark Metro station (Green Line) is a short walk from the building. Street and garage parking nearby is limited, so public transit is recommended.

Arrival and Security

Plan to arrive by 8:30 AM ET when check-in and security screening open, so you can clear building security and find your seat before the 9:00 AM ET start.

- Bring a REAL ID — a state-issued driver's license or identification card that meets the minimum security standards established by the REAL ID Act of 2005.
- Standard security screening applies. Bag size and liquid restrictions may apply. Please follow posted guidance and staff instructions.
- Non-U.S. citizens must be registered by October 7, 2026 and be prepared to provide additional information so building access can be cleared in time.

What to Wear

Attendees should dress in business casual attire.

Food and Drink

The program runs from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM ET with no lunch break, so plan to eat beforehand or buy lunch nearby — cafés and quick-service options are within a short walk of the building. Lunch is not provided. Please plan to bring or buy your own beverages; water fountains are available in the building. We will confirm any on-site refreshments in the final details email.

Wi-Fi

Guest Wi-Fi is available. Select the “DOT guest” network and register your contact details in the sign-in portal to receive a temporary access password for the day. No password is needed in advance.

Accessibility

The venue is accessible, with step-free ramp access to the stage. ASL interpretation and other accommodations are available on request. Please send accommodation requests to FLOW@dot.gov by Wednesday, October 7, 2026 so we can plan appropriately.

Session Access

The morning plenary session is open to everyone on the attendee list. The breakout sessions and closing are for FLOW members only.

Attendee Contact Sharing

Your registration details are provided to USDOT security in advance so building access can be cleared. Separately, by registering you agree that your name and email address may be included on an attendee list shared with participants after the meeting. This supports networking and follow-up across the FLOW community.
