


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# **DOMESTIC AIRLINE FARES CONSUMER REPORT**



Fourth Quarter 1998 Passenger and Fare Information

## FARE INFORMATION FOR CONSUMERS

Each month the Department of Transportation releases an Air Travel Consumer Report that includes information about various service quality elements, including flight delays, mishandled baggage, and oversales, and a variety of other types of consumer complaints.

In response to an increasing number of inquiries from consumers about domestic airline prices the Department decided to release a quarterly fare report. The first such report, for the third quarter of 1996, was released in June 1997. This is the tenth report, and is based on data for the fourth quarter of 1998.

The initial report provided information about average prices being paid by consumers in the 1,000 largest domestic city-pair markets within the 48 contiguous states. These markets account for about 75 percent of all 48-state passengers and 70 percent of total domestic passengers. This report includes the top 1,000 city-pair markets for the fourth quarter of 1998, plus 195 additional city pairs that have been in the top 1,000 during previous quarters covered by this report series.

Tables 1 through 5 contain the same information as previous reports. As with the other reports, a special feature has been included to provide more in-depth analysis of the effect of low-fare service on fares.

For each market, Table 1 lists the number of one way passenger trips per day, the nonstop distance, the average market fare, and identifies the airlines with the largest market share and the lowest average fare; market share and average fares are provided for both airlines. Average fares are average prices paid by all fare paying passengers. They therefore cover first class fares paid to carriers offering such service but do not cover free tickets, such as those awarded by carriers offering frequent flyer programs.

Airlines tend to offer a wide variety of prices in any given market and it is unlikely that the average fares from this report will be the same as any particular fare offered. Nevertheless, information about average fares charged, including fares charged by dominant carriers and lower-cost competing carriers where available, can provide useful consumer information. Also, fare comparisons between markets allow consumers to further evaluate prices.

In particular, a high average fare in a market is an indication that a broad range of fares is available and that the number of seats sold at low fares are likely to be both very limited and subject to various travel restrictions. In such markets travelers must make extra efforts to get the lowest price for the service they want. To assist consumers in making average fare comparisons, Table 1 segregates markets by mileage block, since distance is a major factor that affects the level of prices charged.

Markets are then sorted within each mileage block by fare amount, from the highest average fare to the lowest. Consumers should understand that because carriers tend to offer a variety of prices in a market, carriers with higher average prices might offer some seats at prices as low as, or even lower than, carriers with much lower average prices.

The information contained in Table 1 reveals that in many markets the average fares are quite different from carrier-to-carrier. In some instances this reflects differences in service, such as connecting versus nonstop service, or service to different area airports. Note that the "lowest fare carrier" is the carrier with the lowest average fare that has at least a 10 percent share of the traffic in the market, except for markets where only a single carrier has a 10 percent or greater share. In such markets the carrier with the lowest average fare is identified even if its market share is less than 10 percent. In some markets the "market average" fare will be lower than the fare for the "lowest fare carrier" because several carriers that do not individually account for a 10 percent share can collectively account for a significant share. Often they charge lower average fares than individual carriers with greater market participation.

In Table 2, the data are summarized by city. The information provided includes the number of city-pair markets in the top 1,000+ that involve each city (e.g., 10 for Burbank), the number of passengers traveling to and from each city, the average fare, average fare per mile (yield), and average distance traveled. The data are sorted by distance.

Data are provided for markets that experienced changes in average fares of more than 30 percent compared with one year ago. Markets with large increases are shown in Table 3 and markets with large decreases are shown in Table 4. Each market's average fare and total passenger count are provided, along with the absolute and percent change in both average fares and passengers.

Table 5 provides detailed fare information for short-haul, high-fare markets. For a more complete explanation, please read the introductory information at the beginning of Table 5 itself.

This quarter's special feature focuses on Airtran's influence over fares in Atlanta markets.

Recent changes in aviation data reporting requirements, instituted in the first quarter of 1998, may cause some inconsistencies in the carrier data published in this report. Data for the first quarter of 1998 forward will reflect information on marketed carriers only. For instance, if a major carrier's commuter affiliate operated a flight under the major carrier's code, the passengers on that flight would be considered passengers of the major carrier. In previous quarters, those passengers may have been considered passengers of the commuter affiliate that actually operated the flight, or might not have been a part of the Origin & Destination Survey at all. Traffic carried by some commuter affiliates was not

recorded in the DOT's Origin and Destination Survey prior to the first quarter of 1998. Therefore, what looks like a tremendous increase in traffic in certain markets may actually be the result of an improvement in data collected.

As discussed earlier in this report, airlines offer a wide variety of prices in any given market, and it is unlikely that the average fares listed in this report will match any particular fare being offered. A high average fare usually indicates that a broad range of fares is offered in the market. It is likely that low fare seats in these markets are offered in limited numbers, and are subject to various travel restrictions. Fares in markets with low average fares tend to be clustered closely around the average fare. Because only a small percentage of passengers in these markets pay high fares, it is much easier for consumers to find competitive prices. In markets with high average fares, consumers must make extra efforts to get low price service.

The attached table shows detailed fare and passenger data for all city-pairs with a stage length of less than 750 miles that have average fares above \$200. Fare and passenger information is provided for individual competitors in the market. Any airline that carries ten percent or more of the passengers in a market is considered a competitor for the purpose of this report. Following the high-fare markets, identical information is provided for city-pairs with a stage length of less than 750 miles that have an average fare of \$60 or less.

The markets covered in Table 5 were limited in this manner for the sake of brevity. The 750-mile stage length was chosen for demonstrative purposes, because a greater percentage of passengers are affected by fare disparities in short-haul markets with high average fares. The same data for all markets covered in this report can be found on the Internet at <http://ostpxweb.dot.gov/aviation> under "What's Hot."

For each competitor in the market, the table shows the number of passengers carried, the competitor's market share, and the competitor's average fare. To demonstrate the various levels of fares within these markets, we show the least and most expensive \$25 fare interval available to at least five percent of passengers in the market, along with the percentage of the competitor's passengers that flew in those fare intervals. The fare listed is the top of the \$25 fare increment. The last column shows the percentage of each competitor's traffic that flew at fares greater than three times the least expensive significant fare interval.

For example, American Airlines flew 17,510 passengers between Chicago and White Plains, NY, or 33% of market passengers, at an average fare of \$272. American's *Minimum \$25 Fare Interval* between Chicago and White Plains, NY is \$125; the percent of passengers in that interval was nineteen percent. This means that nineteen percent of American's passengers in this market paid between \$101 and \$125 each way. The \$101 to \$125 fare interval was the lowest in which at least five percent of American's passengers flew. American's *Maximum \$25 Fare Interval* is listed as \$550; the percentage of passengers in that interval is nine percent. This means that nine percent of American's Chicago-White Plains passengers paid between \$526 and \$550 each way. The \$526 to

\$550 fare interval was the highest in which at least five percent of American's passengers flew. Thirty-one percent of American's passengers paid more than \$375 (three times \$125, the top of the lowest significant fare interval for American in this market).

## **SPECIAL FEATURE**

### **Airtran's Influence on Atlanta Fares**

In order to highlight the positive effect that low-fare competition has had on the airline industry, this Special Feature focuses on Airtran's impact on Atlanta's local traffic and fare levels. Airtran held approximately ten percent of local Atlanta market share at the end of 1998, compared to Delta's 64 percent. Despite this relatively small share of total market share, Airtran's exercises great influence in the markets it does serve.

To demonstrate this influence, we have examined 68 Atlanta city-pairs<sup>1</sup> in the third quarters of 1997 and 1998. Because of a high level of Airtran entry and exit activity between these two periods, the third quarter comparisons were more illustrative of the effects of low-fare service on fares than the more recent fourth quarter. Three comparisons are made to demonstrate the impact of low-fare service in Atlanta markets: change in passenger traffic and fares in markets when Airtran enters a market, change in passenger traffic and fares when Airtran exits a markets, and the difference in fares and passenger levels in markets that had Airtran competition in both periods and markets that had Airtran competition in neither period.

#### **New Low-Fare Entry**

Out of the 68 Atlanta city-pairs in the top 1,000 domestic markets, Airtran started competitive service in six between the third quarter of 1997 and the third quarter of 1998. Passenger traffic increased between 45% and 100% in all markets after Airtran entry. Average fares fell between 30% and 51%.

## Loss of Low-Fare Competition


Airtran exited four Atlanta city-pairs between the time periods examined. On average, passenger traffic in these markets dropped by 25 percent after Airtran's departure, while fares increased 55 percent. The one exception seems to be the Atlanta-Mobile, AL market, where traffic stayed nearly level and average fares actually declined. However, examination of fourth quarter 1997 and 1998 data shows that Atlanta-Mobile traffic declined by 20 percent, accompanied by a 25 percent increase in fares. The usual effect of Airtran's exit from the market lagged by a quarter.

## Markets with and without Long-Term Airtran Presence

The remaining 58 Atlanta city-pairs were divided into two groups: those that had Airtran competition in both periods examined, and those that had Airtran competition in neither period. The markets were further divided according to distance. Because Airtran concentrates service in short-haul markets, only two distance blocks between the two groups of markets are comparable. In the shortest haul markets (those under 500 miles nonstop), Airtran markets have a third quarter 1998 average one-way fare that is less than half the average fare of non-Airtran markets. In markets with a nonstop distance between 501 and 1,000 miles, non-Airtran markets have an average fare about 30 percent higher than the average fare in Airtran markets.



Passenger levels differ greatly between the two groups of markets as well. Under 500 miles, over 1,000 passengers fly each day in the average Airtran market, while only 309 passengers fly each day in the average non-Airtran market. Once again, the longer-haul

markets exhibit the same pattern. Airtran markets average 1,559 passengers each day compared to an average of 511 per day in non-Airtran markets.
