






Paying for the System

Highway Account


Based on current spending and revenue trends, the U.S. Department of Transportation estimates that the Highway Account of the Highway Trust Fund will encounter a shortfall as early as August 2014.



Mass Transit Account

Based on current spending and revenue trends, the U.S. Department of Transportation estimates that the Mass Transit Account (MTA) of the Highway Trust Fund will have a balance of approximately \$1 billion at the end of FY 2014. The Department estimates that the MTA will encounter a cash shortfall by the end of December 2014.


