

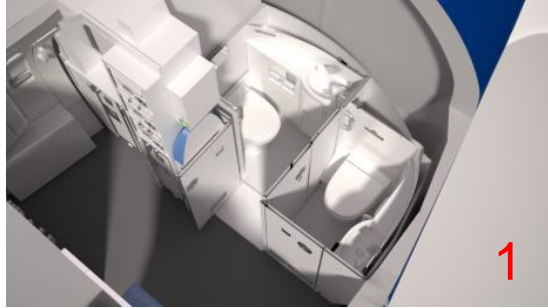

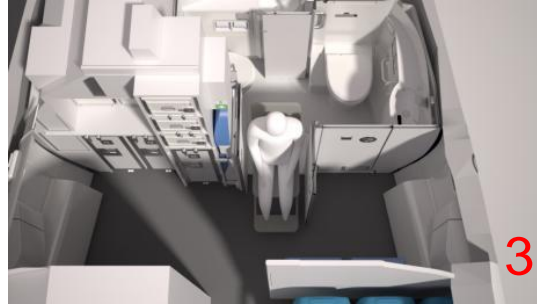

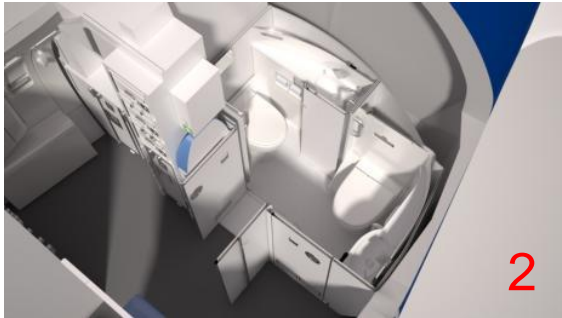

PRM mode



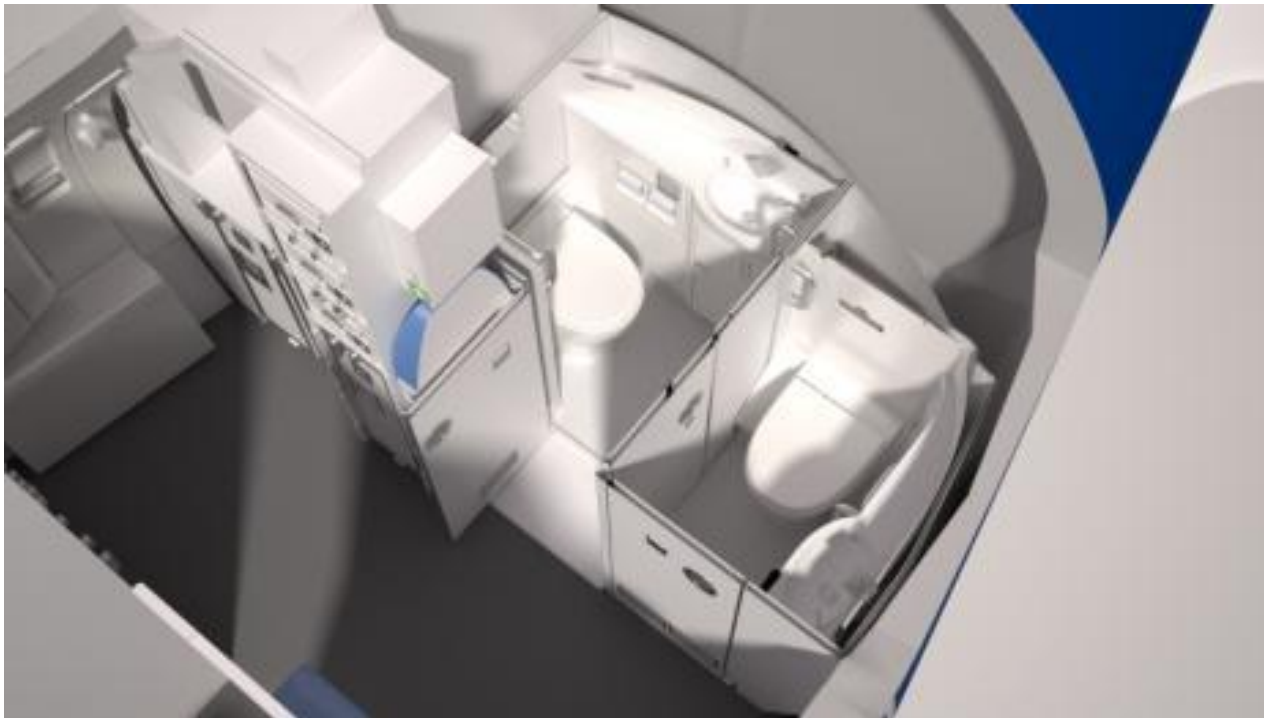

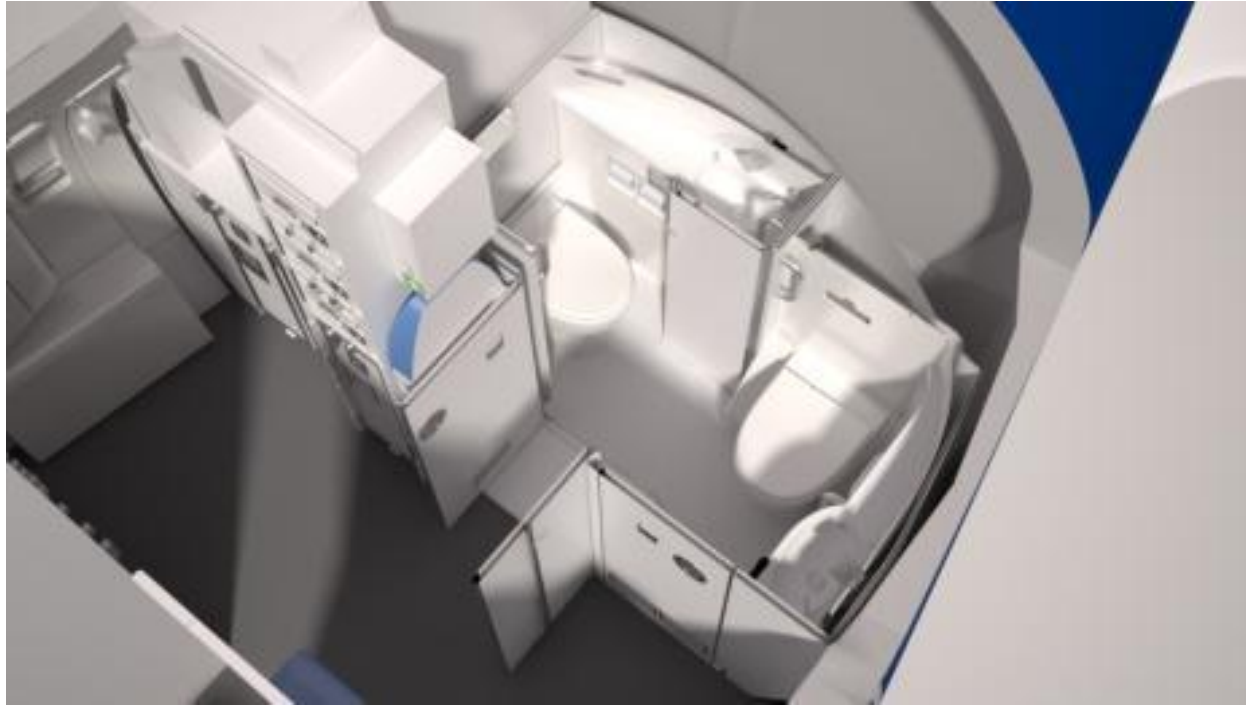

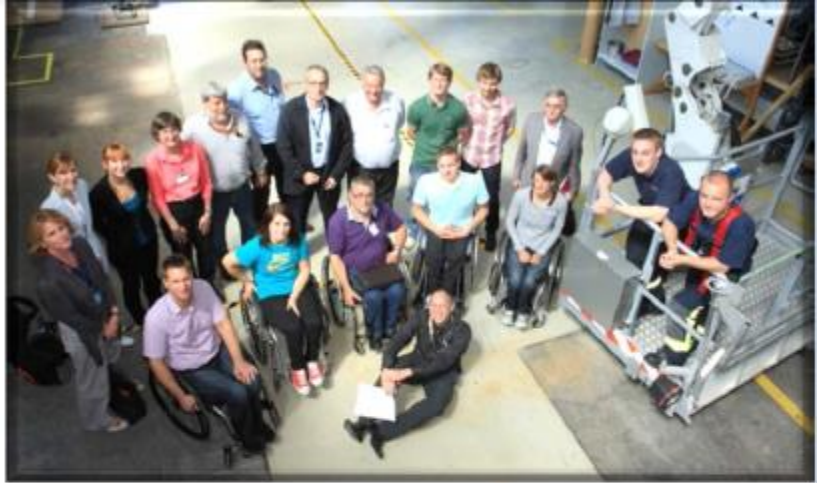
