SUBJECT: Transit Benefit Program Guidance

PURPOSE: This Bulletin provides updated guidance on the Department of Transportation (DOT) Transit Benefit Program.

INFORMATION: Currently, the maximum transit benefit for federal employees who use mass transit and/or qualified vanpools is \$230 per calendar month. Under provisions of Executive Order 13150, Federal Workforce Transportation, dated April 22, 2000, federal agencies are required to provide qualified employees the maximum benefit consistent with the requirements of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) regulations.

On November 9, 2009, the IRS released the Revenue Procedure 2009-50 which states the monthly tax free Qualified Transit Fringe Benefit limits for the taxable year of 2010 will be \$230.

EXPIRATION DATE: This Bulletin will remain in effect until canceled. Bulletin **ET-2009-01** is canceled.
