IA	M-29 Connector	The M-29 Marine Highway Connector establishes a connection between the middle section of the Missouri River in Sioux City, Iowa and the M-70 Marine Highway Corridor at Kansas City, Missouri.	Connector				
IA	M-35 Corridor	The M-35, which can commonly be referred to as “Waterway of the Saints” Marine Highway Corridor, links the Upper Mississippi River with the existing M-55 Corridor. The M-35 Corridor runs from Lock/Mile 1 on the Mississippi River in Minneapolis, MN to the confluence of the Mississippi and Illinois Rivers in Grafton, Illinois, where the M-55 Corridor begins. Together, the M-35 and M-55 provide an all-water route from the beginning of the Mississippi River to the Gulf of Mexico.	Corridor
