MO	M-55 Corridor	The M-55 Corridor includes the Mississippi and Illinois Rivers from New Orleans, LA, via St. Louis, MO, to Chicago, IL, through Louisiana, Mississippi, Arkansas, Tennessee, Missouri, and Illinois. It includes connecting commercial navigation channels, ports, and harbors. It connects to the M-90 corridor at Chicago, the M-40 Connector at Napoleon, AR, crosses the M-70 Corridor at St. Louis, MO, and meets the M-10 Corridor at New Orleans, LA.				Corridor	
MO	M-70 Corridor	The M-70 Corridor includes the Ohio, Mississippi, and Missouri Rivers, and connecting commercial navigation channels, ports, and harbors, from Pittsburgh to Kansas City. It spans Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, and Missouri, connecting to the M-55 Corridor at St. Louis, MO.				Corridor	
MO	M-29 Connector	The M-29 Marine Highway Connector establishes a connection between the middle section of the Missouri River in Sioux City, Iowa and the M-70 Marine Highway Corridor at Kansas City, Missouri.				Connector	
MO	M-35 Corridor	The M-35, which can commonly be referred to as “Waterway of the Saints” Marine Highway Corridor, links the Upper Mississippi River with the existing M-55 Corridor. The M-35 Corridor runs from Lock/Mile 1 on the Mississippi River in Minneapolis, MN to the confluence of the Mississippi and Illinois Rivers in Grafton, Illinois, where the M-55 Corridor begins. Together, the M-35 and M-55 provide an all-water route from the beginning of the Mississippi River to the Gulf of Mexico.				Corridor
