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FOOTNOTES

- 1/ The final rates of compensation for some carriers have expired. Carriers now operating under interim rates pending the outcome of rate renewal and/or carrier selection cases are indicated by an "(I)" after the name.
- 2/ This amount will be paid to the carrier pursuant to the rate agreement in each case assuming that the carrier operates at the agreed-upon completion factor.
- 3/ Annual subsidy subject to revenue sharing adjustment.
- 4/ Air Midwest's total rate is for Lamar, Colorado as well as Dodge City, Garden City, Goodland, Great Bend, Hays, Hutchinson, Parsons/Independence, and Liberal, Kansas. One-ninth of the rate is allocated to Lamar and eight-ninths is allocated to the Kansas points based solely on the average per point served.
- 5/ Prime Air's total rate is for Mt. Vernon, Illinois as well as Clarksville, Tennessee. One-half of the rate is allocated to Mt. Vernon and one-half is allocated to Clarksville based solely on the average per point served.
- 6/ Alliance's total rate is for Manistee and Menominee, Michigan as well as Manitowoc, Wisconsin. Two-thirds of the rate is allocated to the Michigan points and one-third is allocated to Manitowoc based solely on the average per point served.
- 7/ Big Sky's total rate is for Glasgow, Glendive, Havre, Lewistown, Miles City, Sidney, and Wolf Point, Montana as well as Williston, North Dakota. Seven-eighths of the rate is allocated to the Montana points and one-eighth of the rate is allocated to Williston based solely on the average per point served.
- 8/ Midcontinent's total rate is for Columbus and Norfolk, Nebraska as well as Yankton, South Dakota. Two-thirds of the rate is allocated to the Nebraska points and one-third is allocated to Yankton based solely on the average per point.
