Description of Incident:

A pet cat "Bell" was accepted for transport in Baltimore, MD (BWI) destined for Honolulu, HI. Bell was accepted in apparent good health with all required documentation present. After acceptance Bell was taken to TSA screening and subsequently delivered to ground operations for transport to the originating aircraft. During ground transport the driver noticed the cat was no longer in the kennel. Airport OPS, ground operations, and USDA all commenced a search for Bell. At approximately 4A.M. on June 22nd airport maintenance located Bell who had suffered a fatal injury in the baggage conveyor system. Bell's family was subsequently contacted and made aware of her death.

Bells suffered a fatal injury from a baggage belt conveyor

Description of Incident:

A pet AUSTRALIAN SHEPHERD "Jake" was accepted for transport in Honolulu, HI (HNL) with a transfer in Los Angeles, CA (LAX) destined for Atlanta, GA (ATL). The canine was accepted in apparent good health with all required documentation present. After acceptance Jake was transported to the aircraft in HNL and loaded without incident. Upon arrival in Los Angeles, CA during transit Jake chewed his way out of his kennel and was recovered by local ground operations staff. Jake appeared to be limping which prompted a Veterinary evaluation. Jake was treated for a fracture to his leg and minor abrasions.

Self-inflicted injuries
